
## MassHealth is important to the people of Massachusetts because it affects so many of us and has a large impact on our economy

1.9 MILLION PEOPLE including some of the most vulnerable in the Commonwealth

















MassHealth is the single largest item in the state budget and brings in significant federal revenues to support the state economy

MassHealth is a significant funder of providers who employ thousands

- It is a source of revenue to many providers and to some health plans
- The health care sector is one of the largest employers in Massachusetts





elders and people with disabilities receive support through MassHealth to cover their Medicare copays and deductibles and some services not covered by Medicare



MassHealth covers critically important services that are not covered by commercial insurance or Medicare

- Community-based services to people with long-term support needs to help them remain in the community

 Wide range of behavioral health services including day treatment, partial hospitalization, crisis stabilization and others



 Supplements other insurance for more than 20% of MassHealth members to cover these critical services
